Amateur Competition

Leading 16 players in each of the scratch, 1st class and 2nd class handicap sections from the two qualifying rounds on Monday and Tuesday play –off in match play rounds. Handicap sections will be Scratch – 10 and 11 – 24. Consolation tournaments on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday for non-qualifiers and players eliminated during the match play stages

Maximum Handicap 24.

Entry Fee £80 (members £40) – includes complimentary practice round on Sunday 4th September (book with professional if required)

A total prize fund of £3,000 will be available and awarded as follows:

Leading 16 qualifiers in scratch, 1st and 2nd class handicap sections :

1st £60, 2nd £50, 3rd £45, 4th £40, 5th £35, 6th £30, 7th £25, 8th £20

Match Play :

Winners £165 + Trophy

Runner-up £100

Losing Semi-Finalists £60

Losing Quarter Finalists £40

Consolation Tournaments :

Total prize fund of £395

CONDITIONS

The competition will be open to amateur golfers who are Members of recognised golf clubs and will be played in accordance with R & A rules and the local rules of King James VI Golf Club.

Maximum handicap allowed is 24. Handicap at start of play on Monday will apply for both qualifying rounds and handicap at start of play will be the maximum handicap to be used during the 5 days of competition ie where appropriate, self reduction of handicap will apply after completion of qualifying rounds and after consolation tournaments but handicaps will not be increased.

In the qualifying stages any player eligible for more than one prize will be awarded the highest value prize available.

In the event of a tie in the qualifying stages, the best last round or count back shall decide.

In the event of one of the qualifying rounds not being completed due to adverse weather conditions, qualification for the match play stages will be based on the one completed round.

All entries to include Name, Address, Home Golf Club and Handicap (Cheques payable to King James V1 Golf Club)

Entry times will be allocated on a 'first come first served basis' although every effort will be made to allocate times within a reasonable time slot to large groups travelling together.

Trophies will be retained at King James VI Golf Club. The Draw will be published in the Perthshire Advertiser and will appear on the club website.

The Competition Committee reserve the right to reject any entry not complying and to amend any of the competition conditions.
